## FAMILY AT-HOME MISSION ACTIVITY

Out of love, God warned Adam not to eat from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, because if he did, eventually Adam would die. <u>Step 4:</u> Bring your lists to the next Families Forming Disciples gathering!


**Step 5:** Advent is around the corner! That means it is time to make your Family Advent Plan!
